(ii) of a building that has a cubic content (as ascertained by external measurement) of not more than 1750 cubic feet, or, where a greenhouse, conservatory, shed or prefabricated garage forms part of a larger building, of that greenhouse, conservatory, shed or prefabricated garage.

(iii) without prejudice to sub-paragraph (ii) above, of an agricultural building (as defined in Section 26 of the General Rate Act 1967), unless it is contiguous to another building of a kind mentioned in that sub-paragraph.

Demolition Notice
